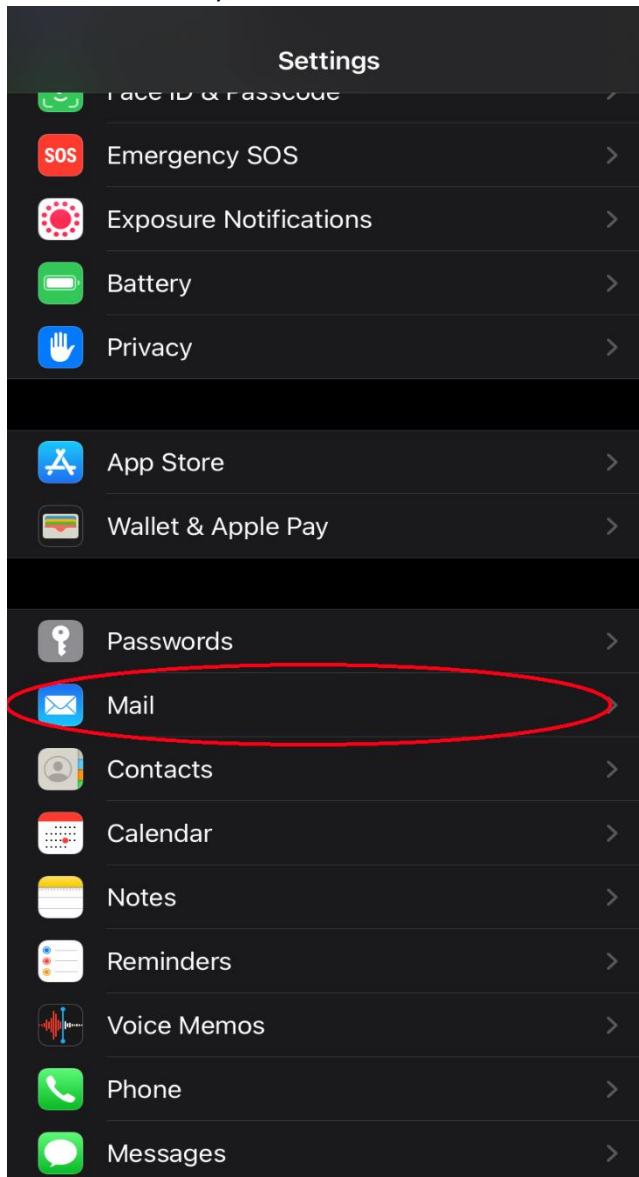
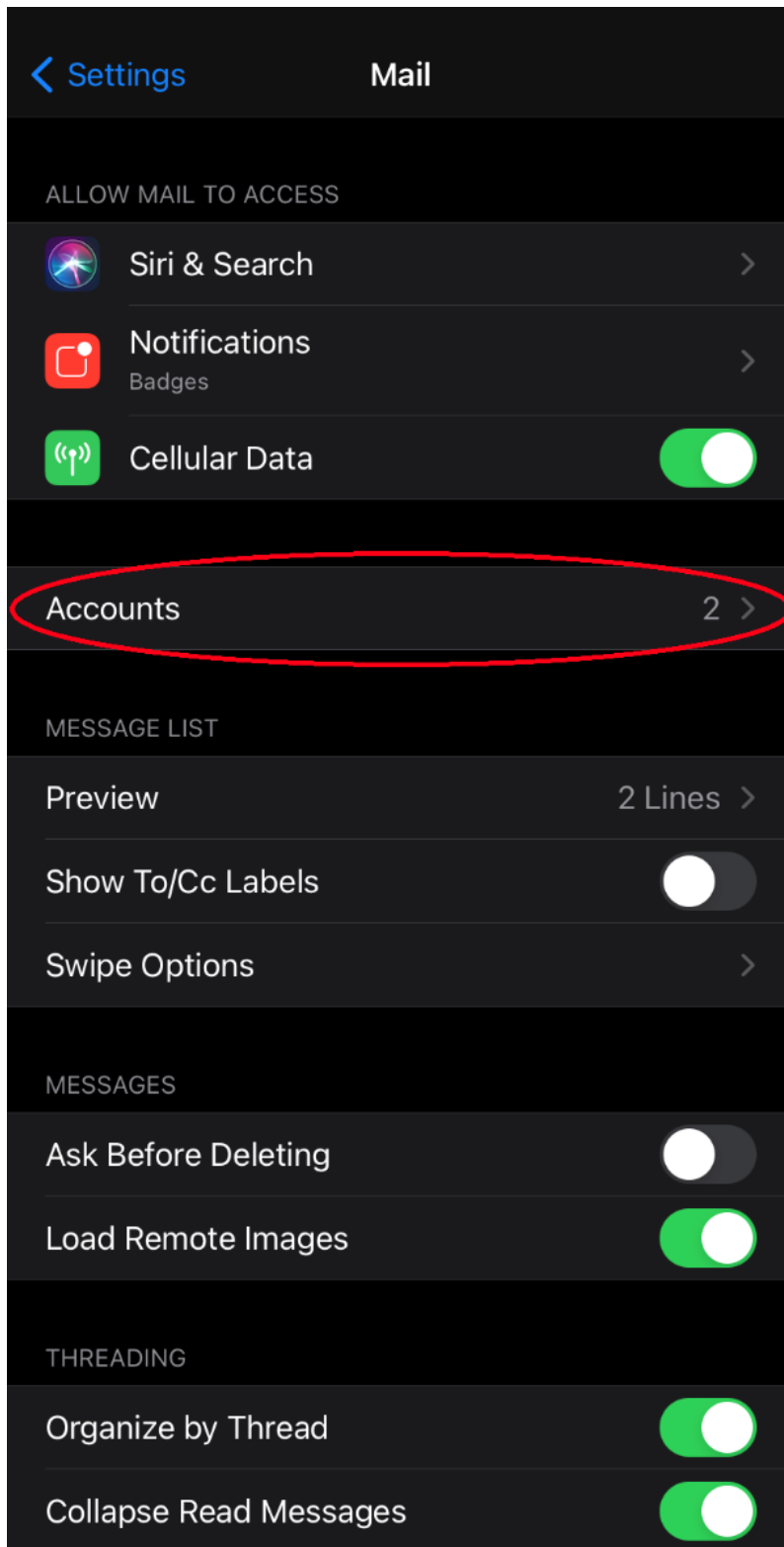


Add a New Email Account Apple

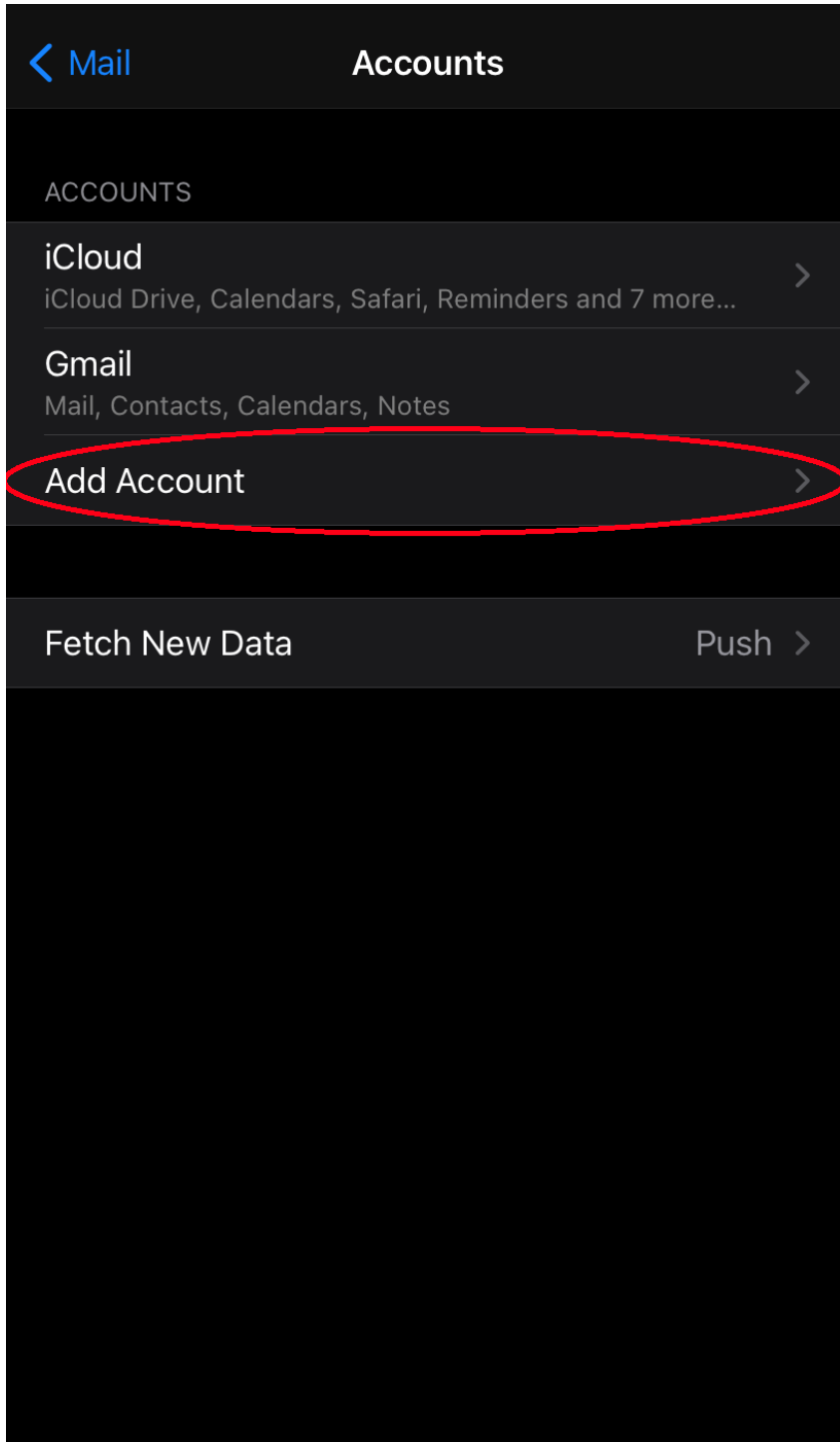
1. Navigate to your **Settings** app.
2. Scroll down until you find **Mail**.



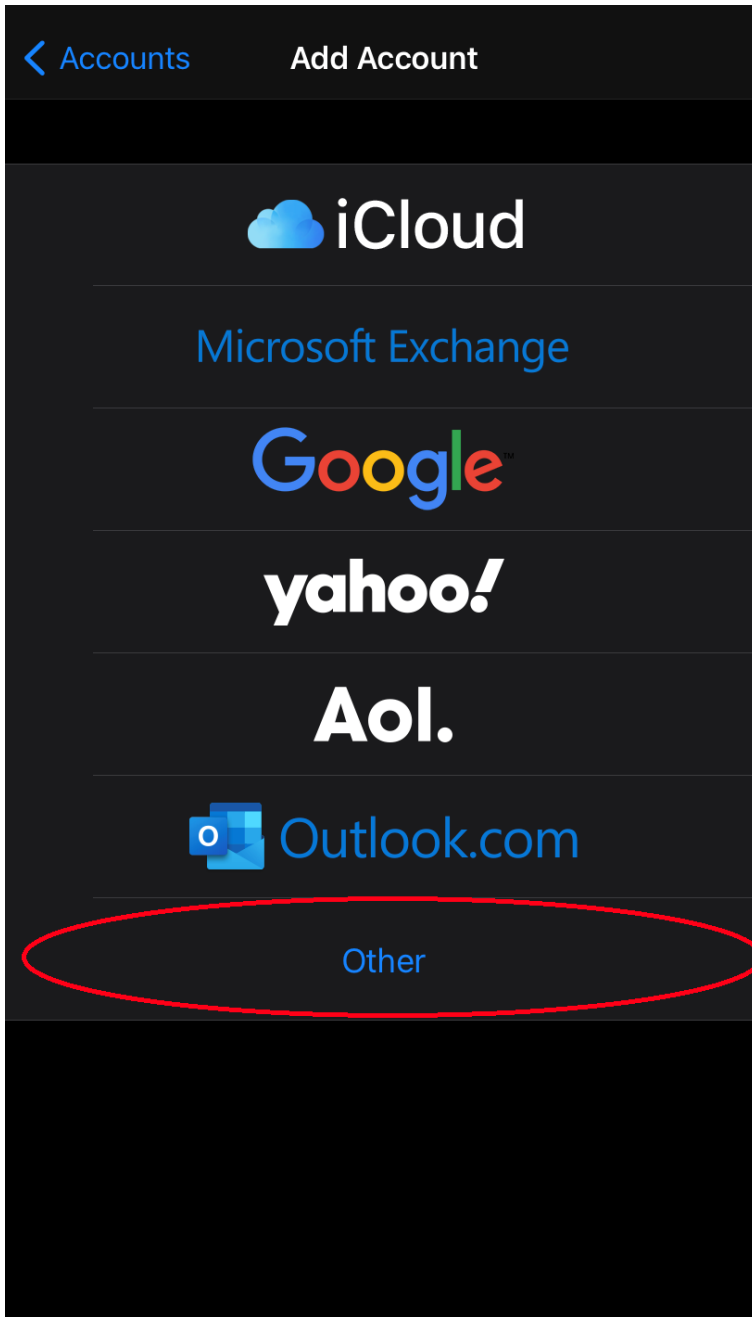
3. When in **Mail** settings, navigate to **Accounts**.




4. Select **Add Account**.
